Crude prices continue to fall. The South Louisiana Sweet average crude oil price fell to around \$10.00 per barrel for the first half of December 1998. The last time prices were this low was in July 1986 when the price was \$10.75 per barrel. London's Centre for Global Energy Studies stated that with oil prices so depressed even military action against Iraq would have only caused a temporary spike in oil prices. The only good news concerning low crude oil prices is that average U.S. retail regular gasoline prices will stay below \$1 per gallon as long as crude stays around \$10.00 per barrel.


