

The Louisiana natural gas spot market price for June is \$4.34 per MMBTU. This is an increase of \$2.13 per MMBTU from June 1999, or 96% higher than last year. The price increase is attributed to growing demand due to addition of gas-fired electric generating capacity, increasingly tight supplies and low levels in gas stock.
