

The Louisiana natural gas average spot market prices for October, 2001 dropped 66% compared to the October, 2000 price. The average spot market price for October, 2000 was \$5.21 per MMBTU. The decreases are attributed to milder than expected winter weather in the U.S., adequate gas storage levels, additional supply from imports, and a plentiful supply of inexpensive heating oil. The price of natural gas is expected to be around \$2 per MMBTU during the winter months.


