

Crude oil prices are above \$30 per barrel and gas prices have risen above the \$5 per MMBTU. The rising of the crude price is driven by speculation and OPEC decision to keep the higher price due to the decline in value of the dollars instead of increasing their production to have more of the marked share. The gas price has risen due to cold weather and unexpected quick storage withdrawals that dropped the gas stock below the 3 trillion cubic feet in the first week of December 2003.

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
