

Oil prices remain around \$43/barrel or 32% higher than the December 2003 average. This is a \$12/barrel drop from October 2004's record high. The fall in prices is contributed to mild weather and OPEC's highest production in 25 years, and has helped rebuild crude inventories in consuming nations. The Energy Information Agency reported a one million barrel increase to 115.6 million in distillate stocks, including heating oil and diesel fuel. This is the first increase since mid-September. Prices have not declined more because of production problems in the North Sea and, also, US diesel demand is up by eight percent from last year's level.

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
