# SEPTEMBER 2007


Natural gas spot market prices continue to fall as gas inventories swell. On June 1, 2007, the price was \$7.37 per MMBTU and on August 3, 2007, it was \$6.13 per MMBTU. This represents a 20.2% drop. With fewer extremely high temperature days in the forecast and a lack of hurricane activity to prop up the prices, gas in storage inventories will continue to climb causing gas prices to fall in the near future. The Energy Information Administration (EIA) of the U.S. Department of Energy reported on Friday, August 17, 2007, that the working gas in storage was 2,926 BCF which was 77 BCF higher than last year at the same time and 333 BCF above the 5 year average of 2,593 BCF.




