
MAY 2008

The natural gas average spot price in April was \$9.94 per MCF. The price was \$2.40 higher than the April 2007 price and \$0.70 higher than the March 2008 price. The higher price is attributed to crude oil prices reaching \$120 per barrel, average gasoline prices above \$3.50 per gallon, the U.S. dollar falling to \$1.59 against the euro, the tight supply in LNG imports and the Independence Hub in the Gulf of Mexico down for an outage. The latest EIA report of the U.S. working gas in storage was 1,285 BCF, as of Friday, April 18, 2008 -- 17.6% lower than the same period in 2007.
